That the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation established by the Federal Farm Mortgage Act of January 31, 1934 (48 Stat. 344; 12 U.S.C. 1020-1020h), and acting in accordance with the policy expressed in Public Law 760, 81st Congress, approved September 6, 1950 (64 Stat. 769; 7 U.S.C. 1039-1039), hereby remises, releases, quitclaims and conveys to the United States of America, to be administered by the Secretary of the Interior, all such right, title and interest as it may own in the minerals in or under the tracts of land in the County of SHELBY and State of ALABAMA, described as follows:

An undivided one half interest in the minerals in the southeast quarter of southeast quarter of section 21 and the east half of the northeast quarter of section 28, in township 21, range 1 west, except 2 acres belonging to Mt.
