I am acquainted with the following land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, namely:

A parcel of land situated in the NW_{\pm}^{1} of SW_{\pm}^{1} , Section 28, Township 19, Range 1 East, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the NE corner of said NW_{\pm}^{1} of SW_{\pm}^{1} and run thence Westerly along the North boundary of said quarter-quarter section 500 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein described; run thence South 320 feet to a point; run thence West 260 feet to a point; run thence North 320 feet to a point on the North boundary of said quarter-quarter Section; thence Easterly along the North boundary of said quarter-quarter section 260 feet to point of beginning.

On October 16, 1948, W. H. Ray and wife, Julia Ray executed a deed to me and my wife, Nora McCay, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 137, page 537. My wife and I purchased the land from the Rays at that time, but an error was made in the description of the property and Julia D. Ray executed deed of correction to me, dated September 10, 1957, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 189, page 102.

Immediately after the execution of the first deed above mentioned my wife and I went into possession of the property described in the deed of September 10, 1957, and lived upon the propertyand cultivated portions of the land until my wife died on May 19, 1955, and since that time I have lived in the house on the property and continued to cultivate portions of it down to the present time.
