COMMISSIONER'S DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that whereas I, John C. Morris, the undersigned Commissioner, heretofore appointed by the Honorable Judge of Probate of said County, to sell certain property hereinafter described, for removal of proceeds from the State and reinvestment, under and in pursuance of an order of said Court directing said sale, and in compliance with the direction of said Commission, to me issued, after first giving notice of the time, place and terms of said sale, by advertisement for three successive weeks in the Montevallo Times, a newspaper published, at Montevallo, Alabama, in said County, did on the 9th day of October, 1957, at public outcry, in front of the Courthouse door at Columbiana, Alabama, in said County, during the legal hours of sale, on said day, sell to W. L. Lawler, Sr., for the sum of SEVEN THOUSAND (\$7,000.00) DOLLARS, that being the highest and best bid for same, the following described property, to-wit:

A lot in the Town of Montevallo, Alabama, more particularly described as follows: Commence where the West line of Melton-Hicks Street intersects the South right of way line of Montevallo and Calera Highway, also known as Highway 25; thence in a Westerly direction along the south line of said Highway 25, 150 feet; thence South and parallel with said Melton-Hicks Street 300 feet; thence East and parallel with the aforementioned Highway 150 feet to the Western right of way line of Melton-Hicks Street; thence North along the West line of Melton-Hicks Street 300 feet to point of beginning. Said land is in the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4, of Section 3, Township 24, Range 12 East,

Shelby County, Alabama, together with all appurtenances thereon situated and there-to belonging.

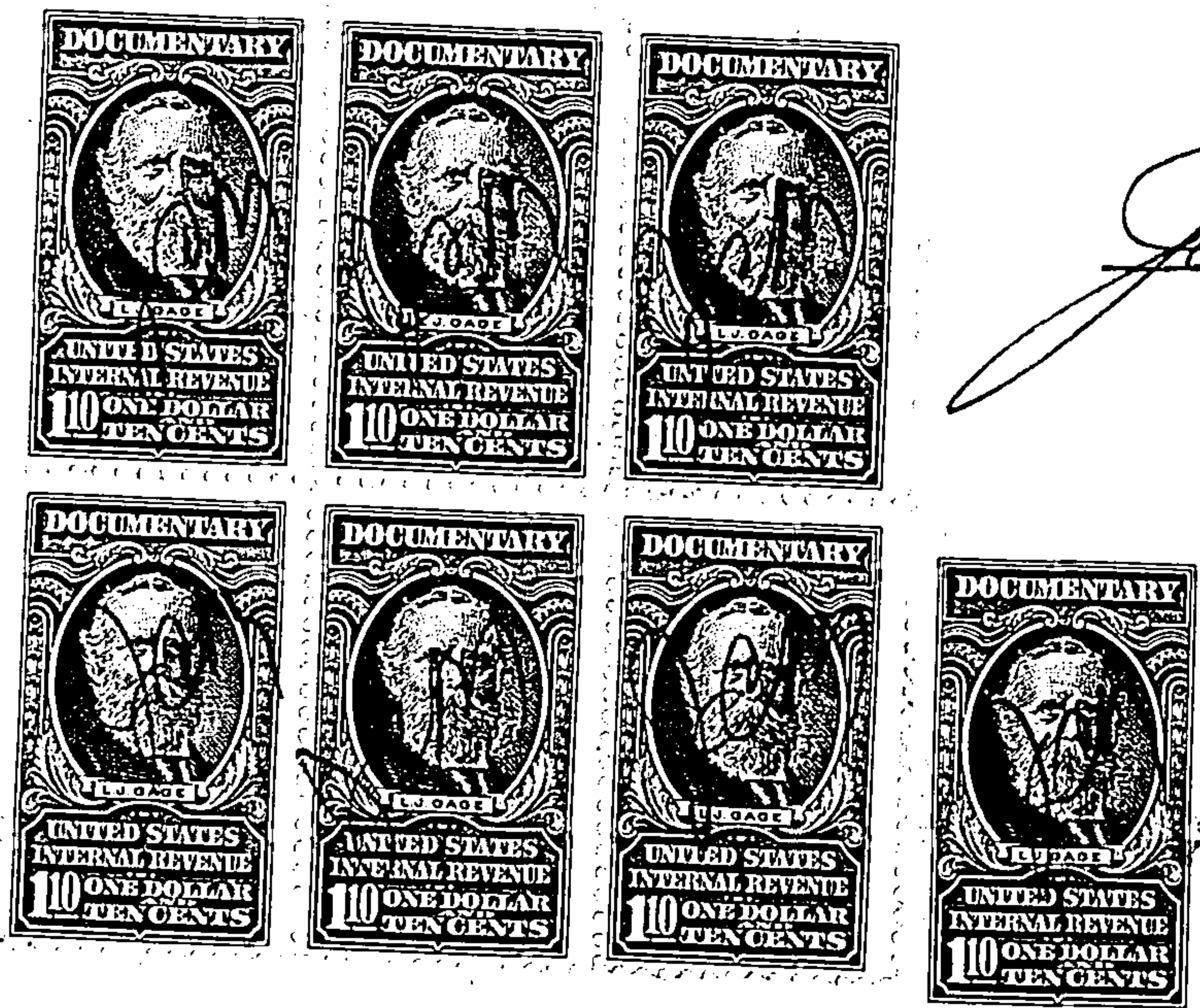
And, whereas, said sale was duly reported by me, the said Commissioner, on the 27th day of January, 1958, the same was confirmed by an order of said Court; and,

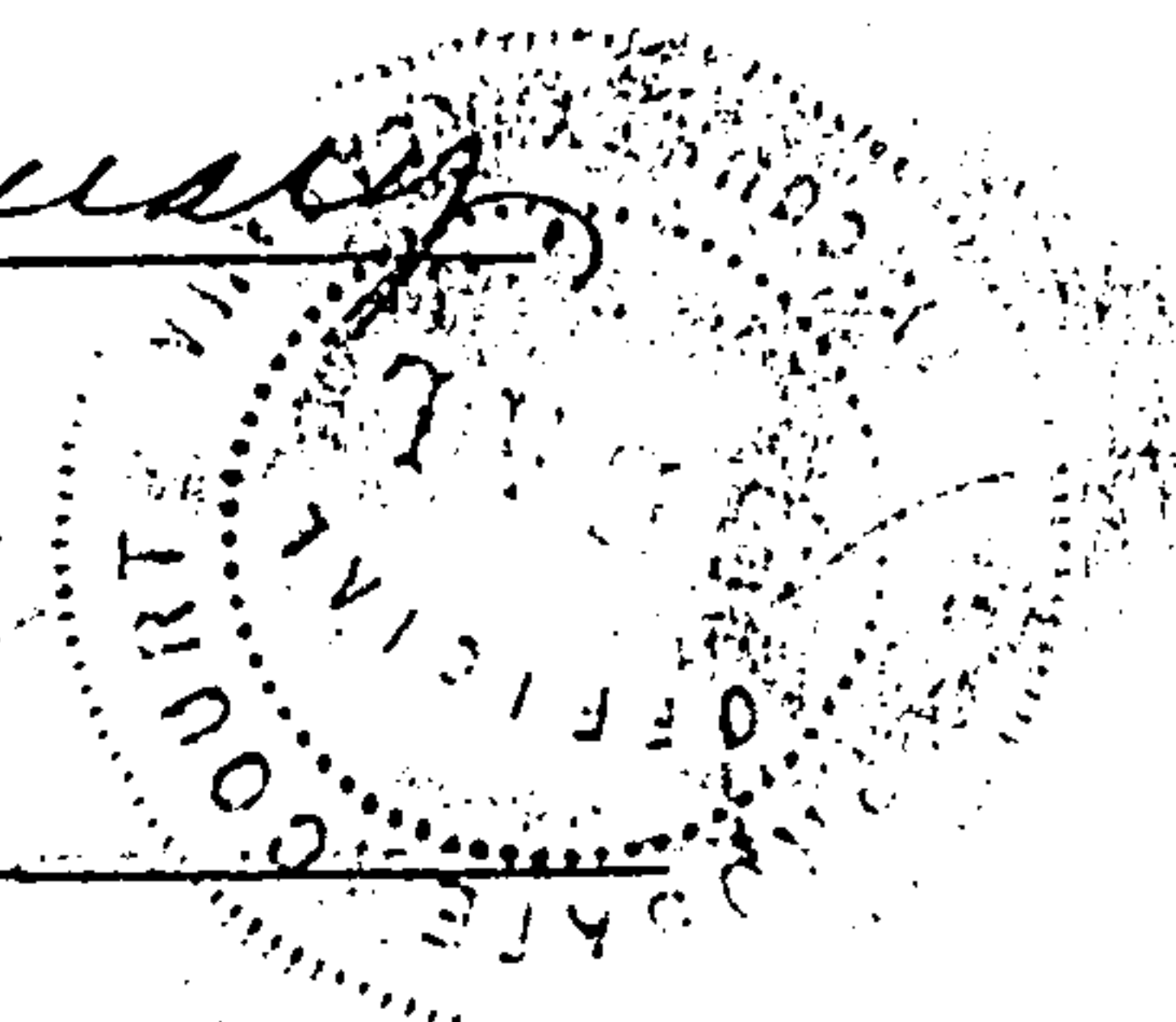

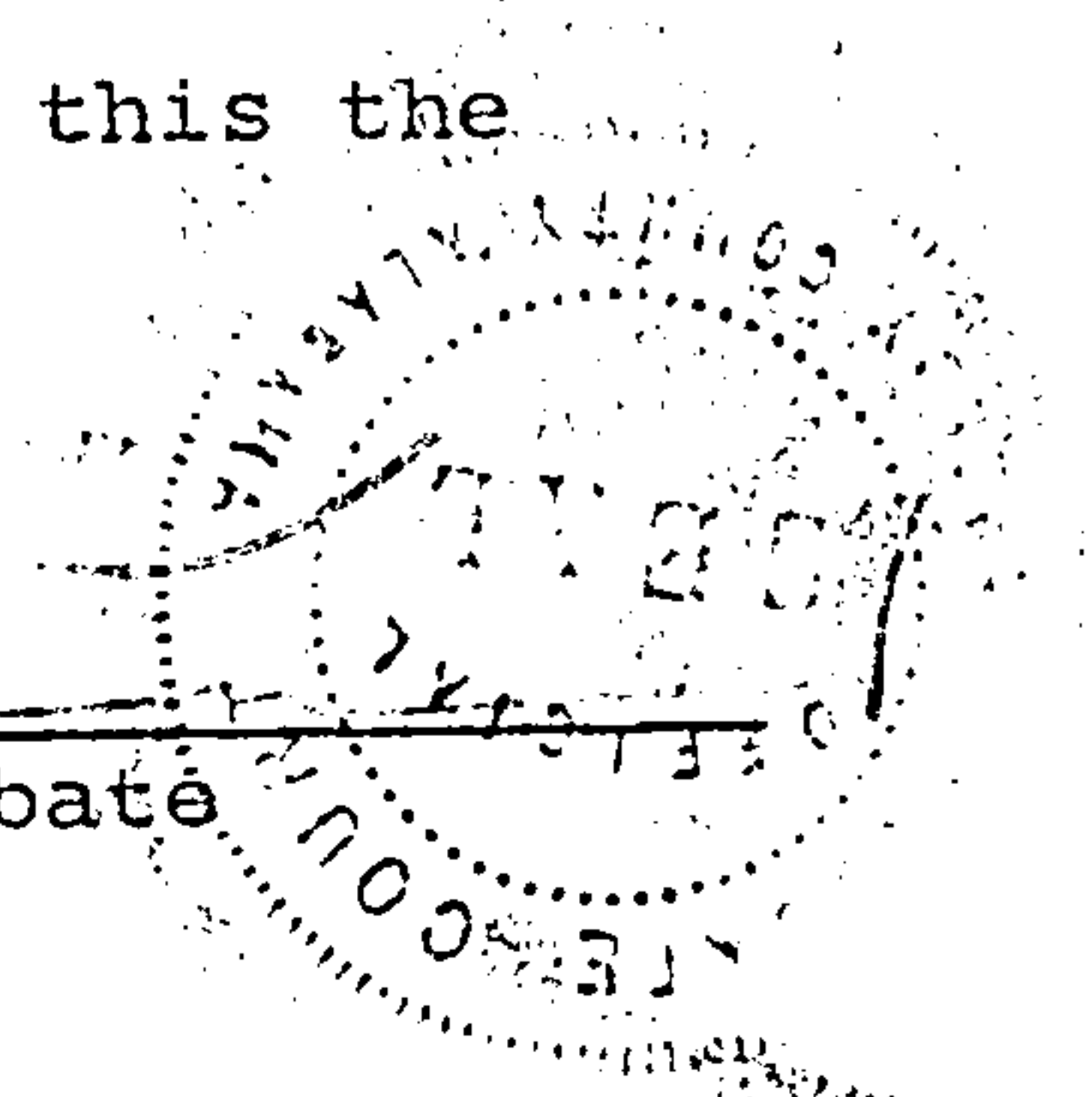
