I am acquainted with the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama, which is now owned by William W. Adams.

I purchased this land from George Huddleston, and obtained a deed from him conveying it to me. This deed was executed on November 5th, 1945, and is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 122, page 286. After the deed was executed I cut the timber from the land and sold it, and paid Mr. George Huddleston in full for the property. I paid One Hundred Dollars in cash and owed him Six Hundred Dollars and I paid that in full.

The mortgage of Frank Johnson and wife, Lula Johnson, and Francis Johnson, an unmarried man, dated March 4th, 1946, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, has been paid.
