Whereas Bennett Davis of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Bennett Davis according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Seventeen, in Township nineteen of Range two East in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa is all at once, containing forty acres and ten hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Bennett Davis

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Bennett Davis and to his heirs the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging unto the said Bennett Davis and to his heirs and assigns forever.

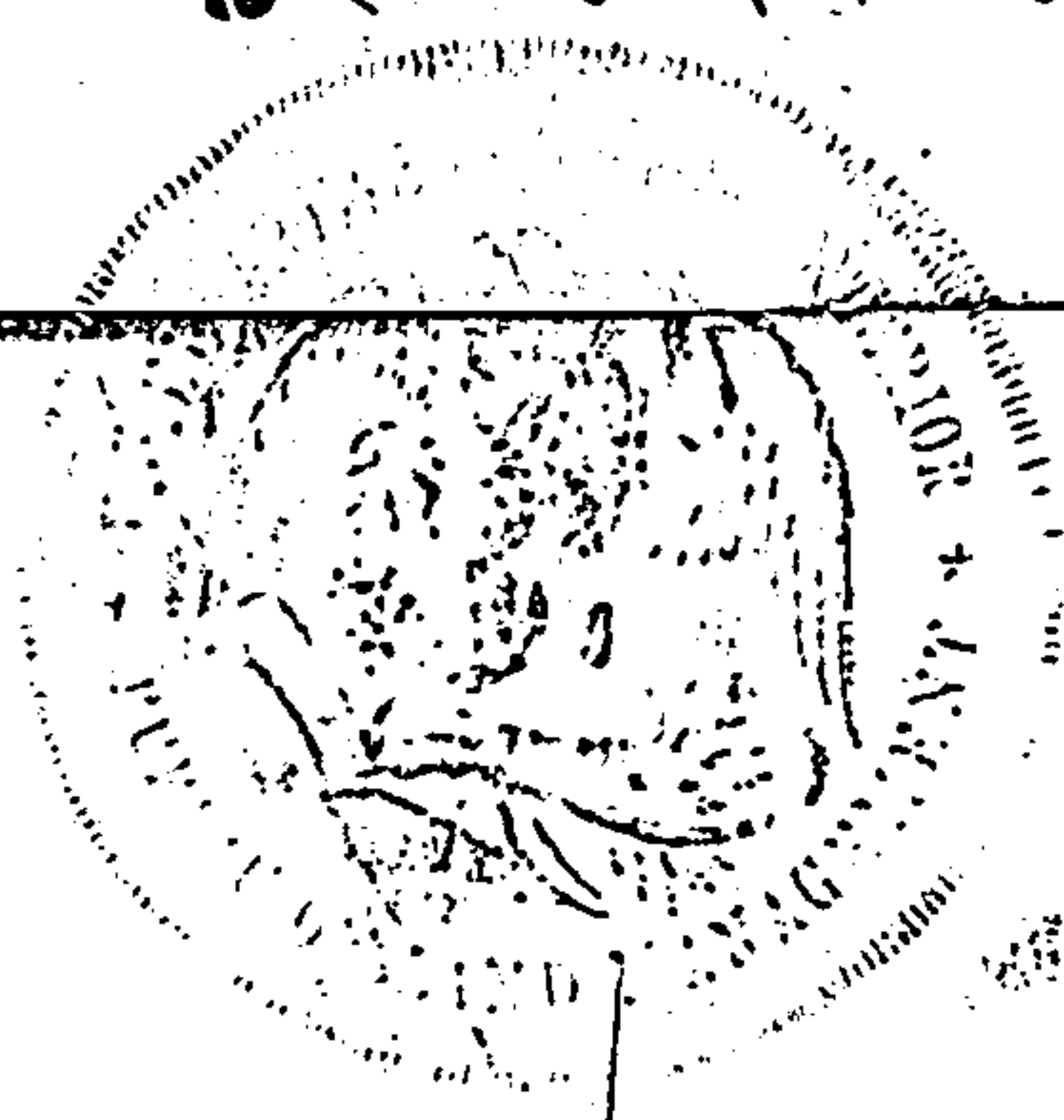
