Before me, the undersigned, authority, in and for said County and State,
personally appeared Mrs. J. N. Knox, who, being known to me and being by me
first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

That she is seventy-three years of age and has been living adjacent to the following described property since her husband purchased the property along with other property from J. T. Braswell in 1937:

That certain tract of land situated in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, described as follows: Starting at the NW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 21 South, Range 2 West and go 43.57 feet East to a point; thence turning an angle of 73 deg and 30' right go 401 feet to the point of beginning on the right of way of the Montgomery Highway for a point of beginning of the tract of land herein described; thence turning an angle of 118 deg. 25' right and go 135.36 feet to a point; thence turning an angle of 104 deg. 45' left and go 345.51 feet to a point on the right of way of the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company; thence turning an angle of 118 deg. 04' left go 295.05 feet to a point on the right of way of the Montgomery Highway; thence turning an angle of 98 deg. 51' left go 215.45 feet along the right of way of the Montgomery Highway to the point of beginning, and containing 1.26 acres, more or less.

That when affiant first knew the above described land, it was owned by Jr. J. T. Braswell. Affiant remembers that Mr. Braswell purchased this land in about the year, 1934. Further deposing, affiant says that she knows that her husband purchased this land from J. T. Braswell, a single man , in October, 1937. Affiant further says that she and her husband, J. N. Knox deeded the above described property to their son, J. C. Knox and his wife, Inez Knox on July 11, 1957. Affiant further knows of her own personal knowledge that J. C. Knox and his predecessors in title have occupied the above described land adversely, for the last past twenty years or more; and she has never heard the title of said J. C. Knox, or his predecessors in title questioned in any way.
