I was a resident citizen of Shelby County, Alabama for 40 years, and resided at Helena, Alabama. I have been well acquainted with the real estate in and around the town of Helena since the year 1886. I remember the lot which was originally known as the C. T. Davidson store house lot. The building on this lot was later occupied by Edward Lee as a crockery store and was on the opposite side of Main Street from Lambert Brothers General Store. This lot was the lot which was known as Lot No. 4, Block 14, according to Joseph Squire's Map of the Town of Helena, Alabama, and this map is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Map Book 3, page 12. This lot fronts 25 feet on Main Street.

My father was C. T. Davidson and I know that the above described lot was the one which was owned by my father and generally reputed to be the C. T. Davidson store house lot.

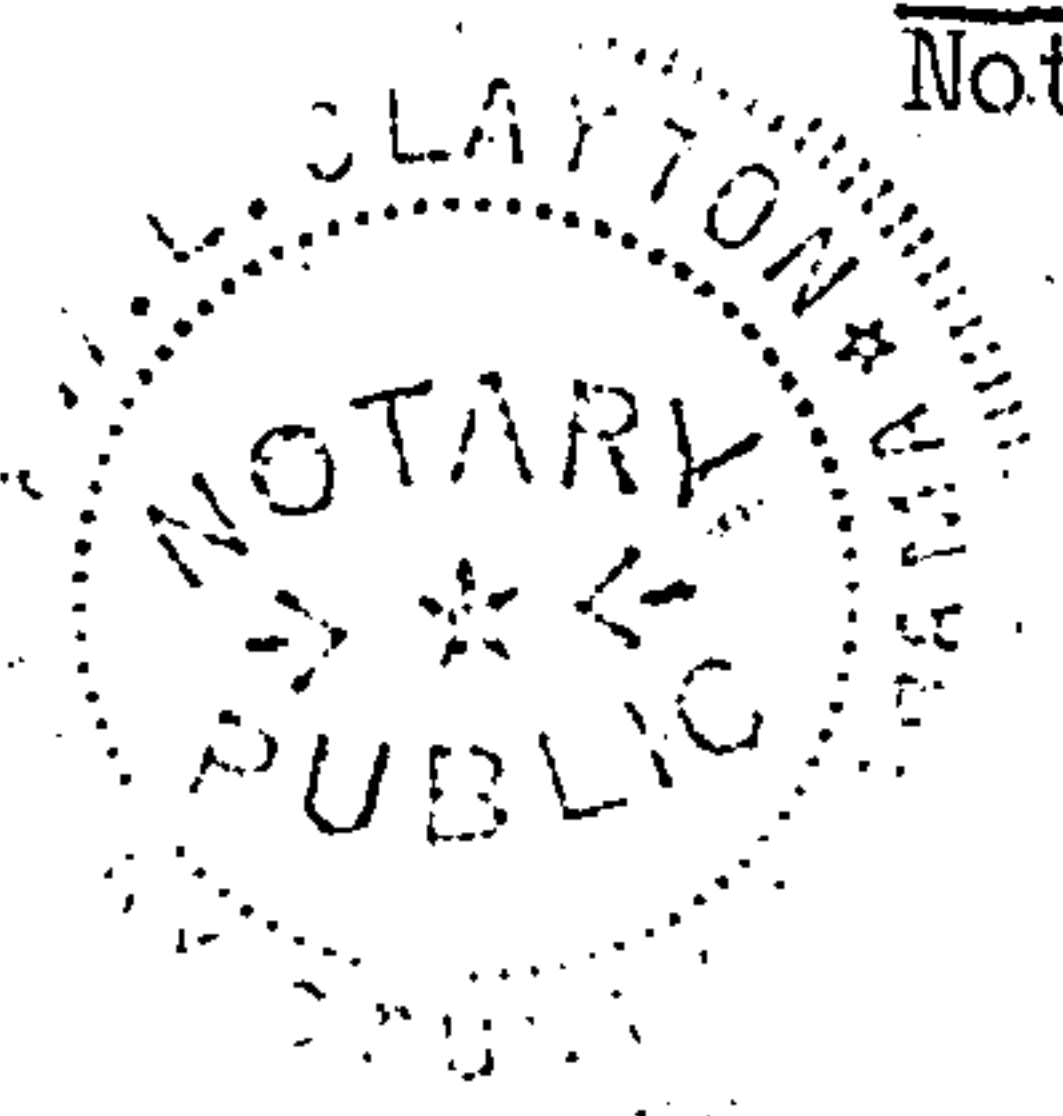
