That the affiant is 54 years of age and is the son of S. C. Perry and wife, Addie Perry. That the said S. C. and Addie Perry had a total of six (6) children, including the affiant, as follows, viz: B. H. Perry; Myrtle Perry Stracener; L. R. Perry; J. W. Perry; L. B. Perry; and Mary Zine Perry Walker. That the said marriage of the said S. C. and Addie Perry to each other was the sole and only marriage of either of them. That neither the said S. C. Perry nor the said Addie Perry had any child or children, natural or adopted, other than those hereinabove named. That the said Mary Zine Perry Walker died intestate in Jefferson County, Alabama, in 1936, and was survived by three (3) daughters, viz: Gwendolyn Walker, Gloria Jean Walker^(DOB 1915) and Billie Mae Walker^(MCGINNIS). 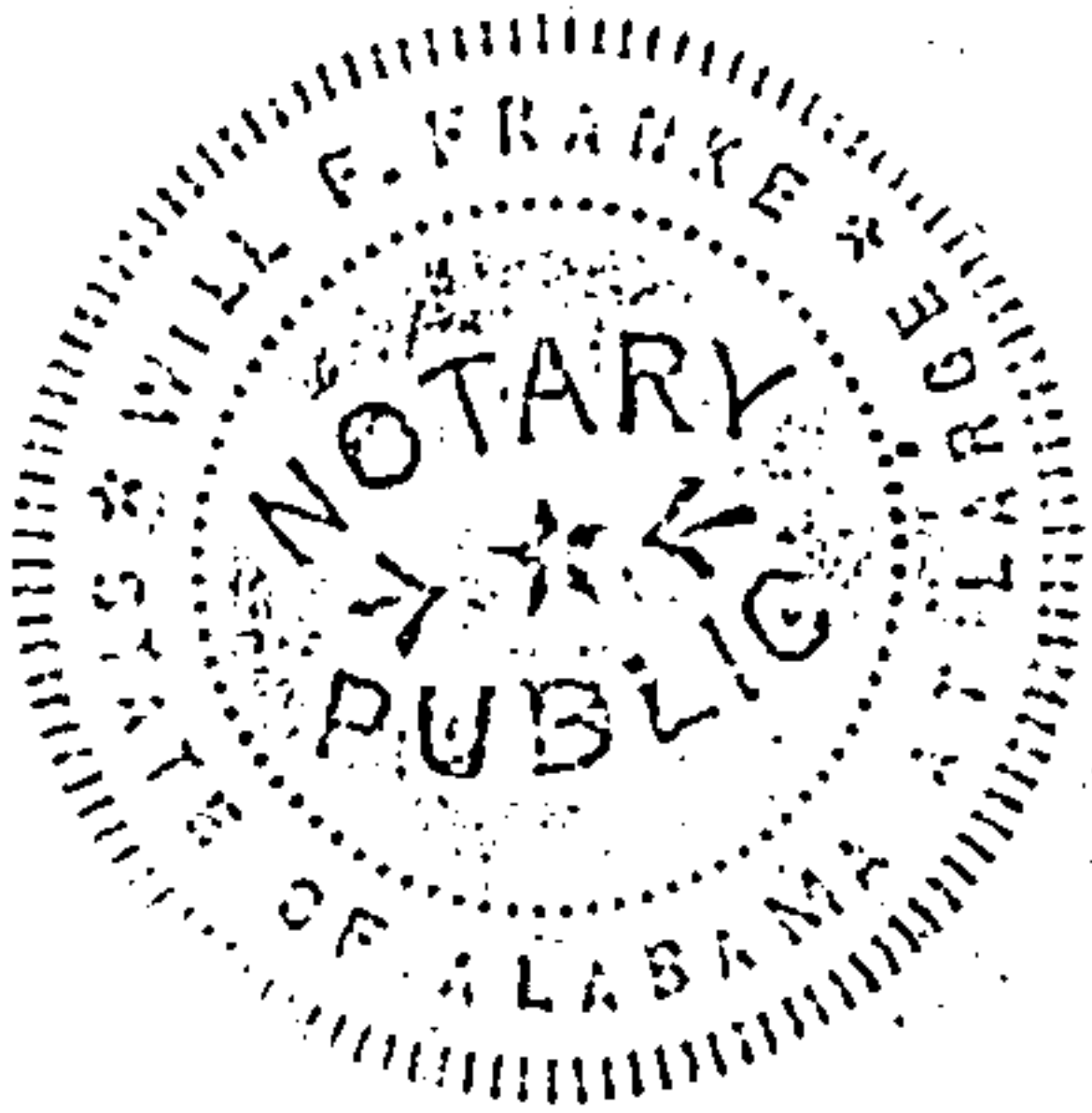
