whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Jefferson County

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the first half of the said first quarter, of section four, in Township twenty five, of Range three north, in the District of Jefferson and State of Alabama containing Eighty acres and twenty hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been per-

ceived by the said Jefferson County

Now know ye, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several

acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Jefferson County, and

to its heirs

the said tract above described: To Have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-

tenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Jefferson County, and heirs and assigns forever.
