Item 1. I desire that all of my just debts, if any, be paid.

Item 2. I give, devise and bequeath unto my two sons, L. S.
Jones and J. R. Jones, \$1.00 each.

I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, all
property, real personal or mixed, of which I may die
seized and possessed, or to which I may be entitled at
the time of my death, with the right on the part of my
wife to use or dispose of any or all of said property
in any manner deemed best by her; and my said wife shall
have the right to sell and convey any or all of said
property, for the purpose of expending the proceeds there-
from or of reinvesting the same at her own pleasure.

Item 3. Reposing the greatest faith and confidence in my said
wife, Minnie Mae Jones, I hereby nominate and appoint her
as executrix under this my last will and testament, and I
direct and declare that she shall not be required by any
court administering my estate to give bond as such executrix,
not to make an inventory of the property coming into her
hands nor to report to nor procure an order of any court
in connection with the proceedings under this will and in
the administration of my estate.
