DECREE OF DIVORCE

This cause, coming on to be heard, was submitted for final decree upon the pleadings and proof as noted. Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court as follows:

FIRST: That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Respondent are dissolved, and the said Elise Lessley is forever divorced from the said Hubert Lessley.

SECOND: That neither the Complainant nor the Respondent shall again marry except to each other until sixty (60) days after the date of this decree. If an appeal from this decree is taken within sixty (60) days neither the Complainant nor the Respondent shall marry again except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

THIRD: That the costs of Court accrued herein are hereby taxed against the Respondent for the collection of which let execution issue and if returned "no property found" then let execution for costs issue against the complainant.

Fourth: Pursuant to the written agreement of the parties filed in this cause, it is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

- A: That the care, custody and control of the minor children, namely: Rene Lessley, Linda Lessley, Patricia Lessley and Debra Ann Lessley, be and hereby is awarded to the Complainant, the mother, with the right to the Respondent, the father, to see said children at reasonable times.
B: That the Respondent pay to the Complainant the sum of \$35.00 per week for the support of Complainant and said minor children, payable on Saturday of each succeeding week after March 1, 1955.
C: That the Complainant and the minor children shall have the use and benefit of the furniture heretofore used by the parties.
D: That the Respondent pay to the Complainant the sum of \$100.00 as attorney's fee for the Complainant's solicitor of record herein.
