My name is Roy Downs. I am President of the Central State Bank Calera, Alabama, and have been for the <sup>past</sup> 13 years. I am familiar with the transactions of said Bank, including mortgage loans made to Porter G. Ellis and wife, Eugenia Ellis, as hereinafter described:

Mortgage dated October 4, 1954, recorded in Mortgage Book 234 Page 465 in Probate Office of Shelby County, Ala.  
Mortgage dated July 13, 1955, recorded in Mortgage Book 239 Page 200 in said Probate Office.  
Mortgage dated November 7, 1955, recorded in Mortgage Book 241 Page 87 in said Probate Office.  
Mortgage dated June 18, 1956, recorded in Mortgage Book 245 Page 31 in said Probate Office.  
Mortgage dated July 22, 1957, recorded in Mortgage Book 250 Page 20 in said Probate Office.

Affiant is familiar with that certain deed from Porter G. Ellis and wife, Eugenia Ellis to E. A. Jordan and Martha Jordan dated September 28, 1954, and recorded in Deed Book 168 Page 411 in said Probate Office, under which Mr. & Mrs. Ellis conveyed certain land to Mr. and Mrs. Jordan. In fact, affiant, as President of said Bank wrote a letter to Mr. Jordan dated March 4, 1957, which has been recorded in Deed Book 187 Page 515 in said Probate Office certifying to Mr. Jordan that said Central State Bank had given Porter G. Ellis and wife, Eugenia Ellis authority to sell said land. Affiant further says that after said deed was executed to Mr. & Mrs. Jordan, that Mr. & Mrs. Ellis made the above described mortgages at said Bank and affiant had the descriptions written in said mortgages. Through some oversight, affiant says he failed to exclude the land conveyed to the Jordans in 1954 by deed recorded in Deed Book 168 Page 411 in said Probate Office, mentioned above. Only one of said mortgages described above is unpaid and affiant, as a duly authorized officer of said Bank and for said Bank, has released said land conveyed by Mr. & Mrs. Ellis to Mr. & Mrs. Jordan from the operation of said unpaid mortgage dated July 22, 1957.

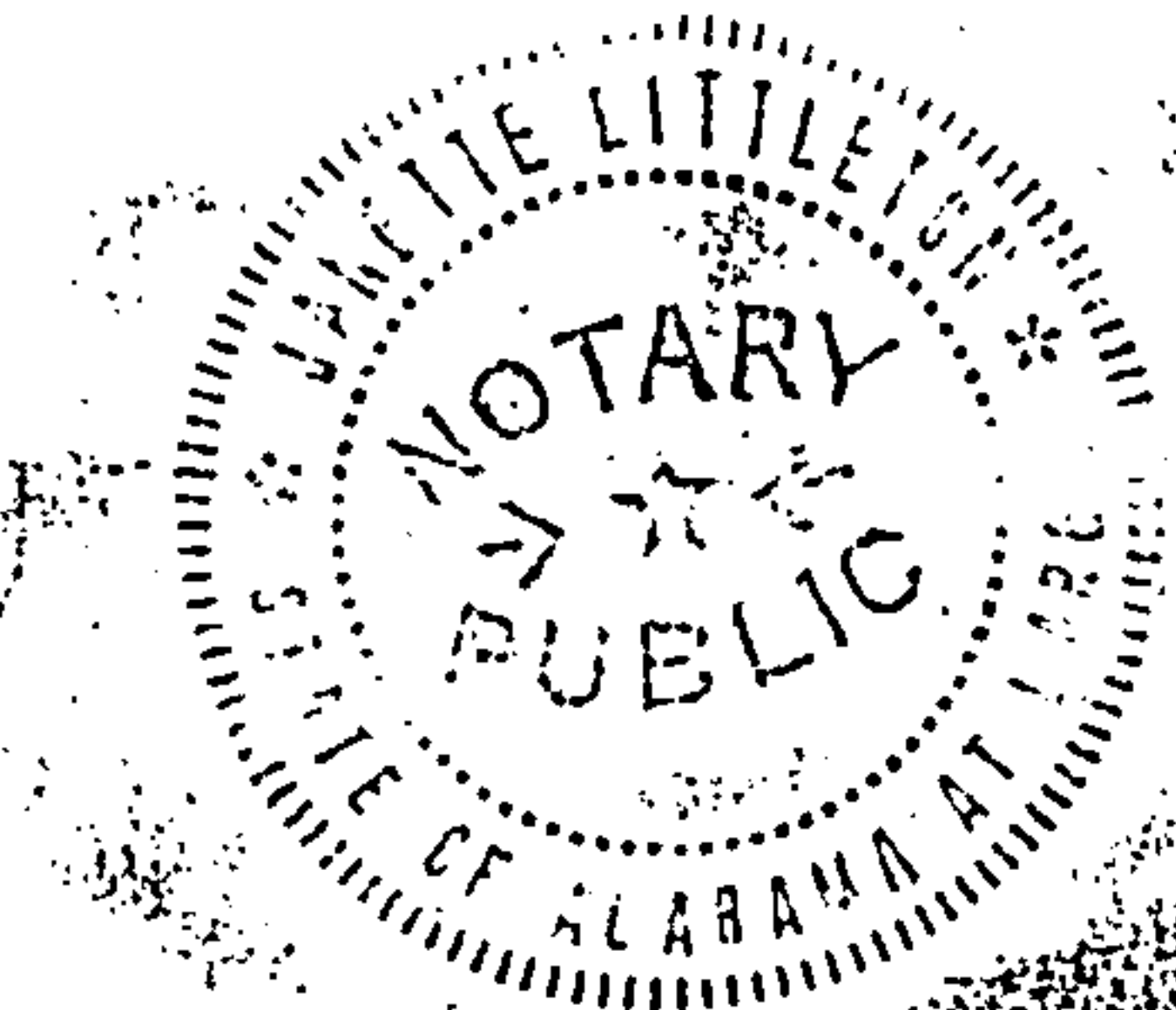
