

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said county in said state, personally appeared Jack Ozley who, after being by me duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is Jack Ozley, I am 44 years of age and live in Calera, Alabama. I am a brother to C. C. Ozley who obtained a warranty deed in the year 1937 from Wilford Ozley and wife Lela Ozley, J. C. Ozley and wife Myrtle Ozley, Dick Ozley, Dillard Ozley, James J. Ozley, Jack Ozley, being affiant, and his wife Thelma Ozley. The said deed was executed and acknowledged on January 27, 1937. It has never been recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County. Said C. C. Ozley died without leaving a will on the 7 day of April 1938, and left one child, a son named L. C. Ozley. C. C. Ozley did not leave a widow.

I am familiar with that certain mortgage executed by W. D. Ozley, a widower, L. C. Ozley and C. C. Ozley to Home Owners Loan Corporation, March 18, 1936, which mortgage was recorded in Mortgage Book 170, page 579, in the Probate Office, Shelby County, Alabama. I know of my own knowledge that the proceeds, being \$800.00, from said mortgage were used by said W. D. Ozley to repair and improve the homestead of W. D. Ozley, which is more particularly described in said mortgage.
