I was acquainted with G. C. Wade, also known as George Wade. I defended him on indictment for the murder of his wife, Nancy Wade, also known as Nancy White Wade, and his daughter, Ann Pillow Wade, in Jefferson County, Alabama, and on December 8, 1935 he was acquitted on the charge of murdering his wife, and the case for the murder of Ann Pillow Wade was nol prossed on May 22, 1936.

Mr. Wade fell dead on the streets of New Orleans, Louisiana, about a year after he was acquitted.

Mr. and Mrs. Wade had no other children except the daughter who was killed.
