I know that A. R. Goodwin and wife, Alma J. Goodwin sold the above described property to James A. Johnson and Dalton Johnson on March 4, 1947 by deed recorded in Deed Book 194 at page 278 in the office of Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama.

I know that James A. Johnson and Dalton Johnson went upon the above described property after purchasing same and cut the timber therefrom.

The possession of the above described property by James A. Johnson and Dalton Johnson from the time they purchased the property in the year 1947 up until their sale of the property on June 15, 1958, by deed recorded in Deed Book 193 at page 518, has been actual, continious, exclusive, open, notorious, adverse, hostile and under color of title and claim of ownership and no persons have ever claimed any right, title or interest in or to said property adverse to James A. Johnson and Dalton Johnson, nor have I ever known of anyone disputing or questioning their title.
