We cultivated garden spots and also another place which we had for a turnip patch. As stated, we were on the property for two years but I do not know just what years they were except that I know when Mr. Patterson or his father-in-law R. E. L. Headley sold the property, Jim White moved on it immediately and stayed there one year and probably two, and we then immediately moved in the house on the property and lived there for two years. Later on the house was burned but I do not know the exact date the house was burned. It was my information then and is now that Jim White rented the property from the same man we did.
