Affiant further says he has lived in the same vicinity of the above described land for the past 36 years and has all along been well acquainted with it. Affiant says he knows of his own knowledge that the water agreement entered into by Mrs. M. L. Strother and Harry N. Ward on May 17, 1935, as shown by agreement recorded in Deed Book 98 Page 397 in said Probate Office of Shelby County, referred to water which was not located on the above described land and affiantt says he also knows that neither Harry N. Ward nor anyone claiming under him has bottled any water on any land covered by said agreement for the past 20 years.

Affiant further says that he is one and the same person as F. M. Strother to whom a deed was made on November 16, 1943, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 116 Page 225 in said Probate Office.
