according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 34th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the first time of the Senate West Quarter of Section thirteen, of Township twenty, Range three West in the District of Columbia and State of Indiana, containing twenty nine acres and seventy eight hundredths of an acre - according to the official plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Missouri Adams

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Merced Betancour* the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Merced Betancour* and his heirs and assigns forever.
