according to the provision of the Act of Congress of the 23rd of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the first time granted of the land grant of section twenty seven, in Township twenty of Range three, West in the District of Land subject to sale at Washington, containing forty acres more or less and a half hundredth of an acre, according to the official plat of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Charles Griffin.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the secret act of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said *afflicted* *English* and to *his* heirs the said trade above described:

We have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, heretofore belonging unto the said *afflicted* *English* and *their* heirs and assigns forever.
