Before the undersigned authority personally appeared Dorothy Bradley, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am acquainted with the following land, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, namely:

PARCEL NO. ONE: The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 20, Range 1 West, except one acre in the Southwest corner described as follows: Commence at the Southwest corner of said forty; thence run East 35 yards; thence North 140 yards; thence West 35 yards to the West line of said forty; thence South to the point of beginning.

PARCEL NO. TWO: A portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 20, Range 1 West, described as follows: Commence at the Northeast corner of said forty; thence West 70 yards; thence South 162 yards; thence East 70 yards to the East line of said forty; thence North to the point of beginning.

PARCEL NO. THREE: A portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 20, Range 1 West, described as follows: Commence at the Southeast corner of said forty; thence North along the East line of said forty to center of Columbiana-Tafton Road; thence along the said road in a Southwesterly direction to the first branch or drain; thence in Southerly direction along said branch or drain to the South line of said forty; thence East along the South line of said forty to the point of beginning.

My husband is W. R. Bradley. Mr. Bradley bought this land from J. L. Moore in 1951. It was deeded to my husband and B. A. Kendrick. There was a house on Parcels Two and Three when my husband and Mr. Kendrick bought it, and my husband and I moved into that house and remained on it continuously until October 6, 1958, and all the while portions of it was cultivated continuously each and every year. My husband claimed this land, subject, of course, to the half interest that belonged to Mr. Kendrick and Mr. Kendrick sold his interest to William T. Syphurs and Mary Lois Syphurs.
