Attorney in fact may do in said premises.

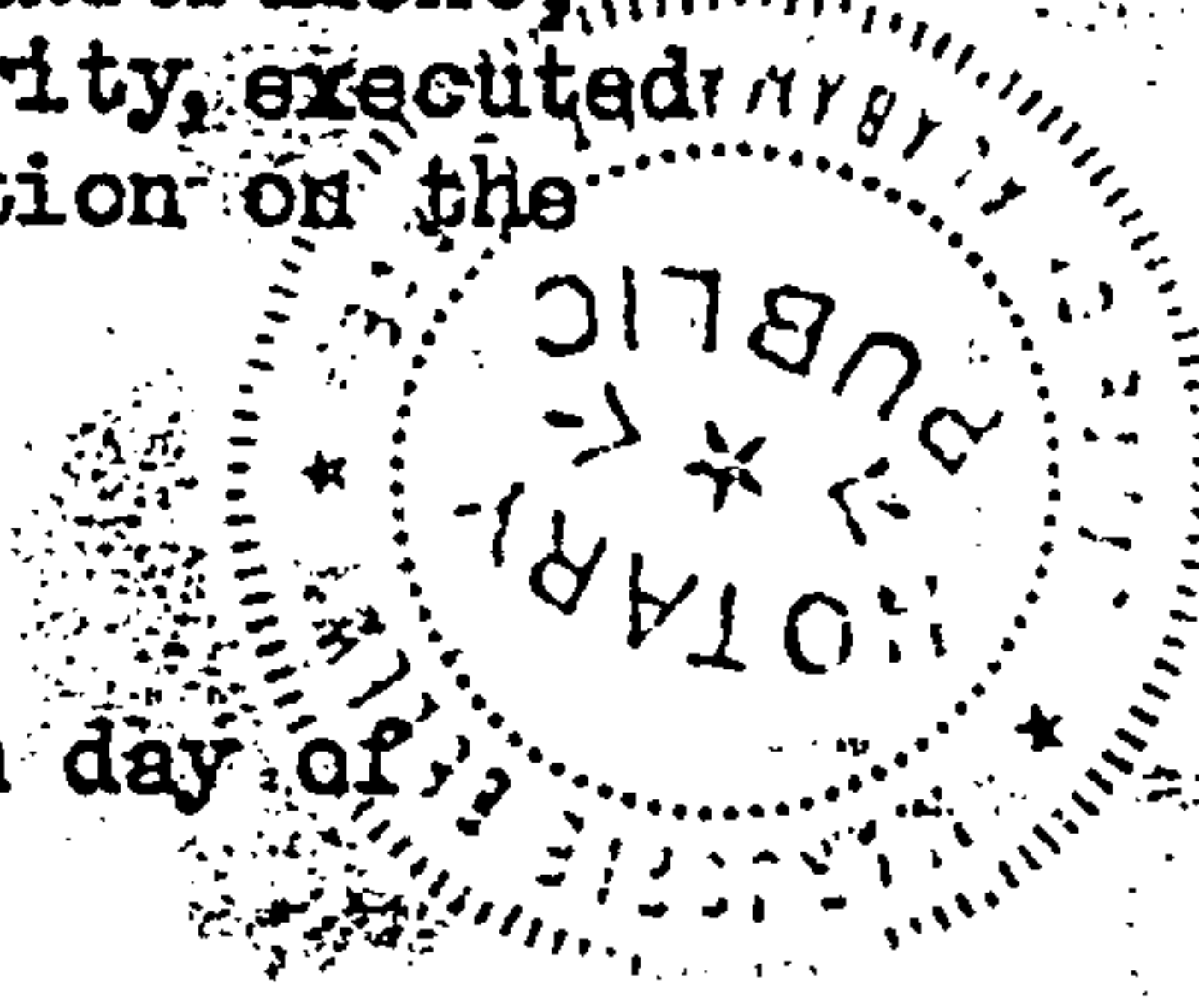
