I, L. C. Walker, Probate Judge in and for said County, in said State, hereby certify that Virgil Howard came before me on this day, and after being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

"My name is Virgil Howard. I am 59 years old and reside in Sterrett, Alabama. I know Jack Davis, and am familiar with the following described lands, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

The  $SE_4^1$  of the  $NE_4^1$  of section seven(7), and  $SW_4^1$  of the  $NW_4^1$  of section eight(8), and the  $S_2^1$  of the  $NW_4^1$  of the  $NW_4^1$  of section eight(8), in township 18, range 2 East of the Huntsville Meridian.

The said Jack Davis and his wife, Mabel Davis, acquired the said lands from Matildy Garner, or Matildy Norman, by deed, in the Fall of 1942, and they have lived on said lands, ever since. I have; never; heard of anyone else making any claim adverse to them. I knew Louie Garner, during his lifetime. He and his wife, Matildy Garner, lived on said lands for several years prior to Louie Garner's death, sometime during the 1920's. Louie Garner's mother and father died before he did, and he never had any brothers or sisters. Matildy, then married a man by the name of Norman, who came from somewhere else, and after a few years, they moved away to Oklahoma, where it was reported that Norman died, and Jack Davis purchased the said lands from Matildy, who was then Norman's widow.
