

Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Curtis Whitfield, who is known to me, and who, being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Curtis Whitfield. I am sixty-six years old and live at Sterrett, Alabama. I have been personally familiar with the possession and ownership of the following described property since E. W. Camerson purchased said property in 1909:

The SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8 and the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, all in Township 18, Range 2 East of Huntsville Meridian, Shelby County, Alabama.

E. W. Camerson went into possession of said property when he purchased the same and built a house thereon, which he occupied for a short time until he sold said property to T. H. Milam. T. H. Milam lived in said house until he sold said property to Louie Garner, a short time later.

Louie Garner and his wife, Matildy, occupied said property as a homestead for several years and until the death of Louie Garner. Matildy Garner moved away, and Matildy Garner sold said property to Jack Davis and wife, Mabel Davis, in 1942. I was personally acquainted with Louie Garner and his wife for several years while they lived on said property, having lived within a quarter of a mile from the house on said property in which they lived during said time. Louie Garner was in his 40's when he moved on said property. Louie Garner had no children and no brother or sisters so far as I know, and I was well enough acquainted with him, I believe, to have known it if he had had any children or brothers or sisters.

Jack Davis and his wife, Mabel Davis, have occupied said property and the house thereon as a homestead from the time they purchased the same in 1942 until the present date (except the lot which they recently conveyed to Cleburn Gordy Jemison and wife, Dorothy Davis Jemison, said Dorothy Davis Jemison being a daughter of said Jack and Mabel Davis), claiming the same against the world and against the claims of all persons whatsoever during said time and being in actual, peaceable, open, continuous, exclusive, undisturbed adverse possession of all of said property, as aforesaid, during said time.

I have never heard anyone question the title of said Jack Davis and Mabel Davis or those through whom they claim their title during the time that I have known said property.
