Ozley and Saranel Ozley-(husband and wife) the receipt whereof is acknowledged we the said Henry Joiner and Perrine Joiner grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Richard J. Ozley and Saranel do Ozley

as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in

Shelby

County, Alabama, to-wit:

For point of reference begin at the intersection of the east right of way line of Line Street with the South line of Woods Ferry Road in the town of Columbiana, Alabama, thence South 12 deg. East along the East line of Line Street 376 feet to the Southwest corner of L. H. Ellis lot, which SW corner of Ellis lot is 12.29 feet East of the curb line of Line Street; thence run South and parallel with the East curb line of Line Street a distance of 154.35 feet to the point of beginning of the lot herein conveyed; thence turn an angle of 93 deg. to the left and run a distance of 150 feet; thence turn an angle of 93 deg. to the right and run a distance of 110 feet; thence turn an angle of 87 deg. to the right and run a distance of 150 feet to the East line of Line Street; thence turn an angle of 93 deg. to the right and run North along the East line of Line Street to the point of beginning. Situated in the SEL of NW% of Section 25, Township 21, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama.
