To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

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Whereas William Moore, of Shelby County,
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a copy of the Register of the Land Office at the place where he resides it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Moore,
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 2d of May 1820 entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for
the sum of one thousand dollars, subject to deduction of taxes or expenses
incident to surveying, Platting, and surveying of land, and to the District of Maine subject to sale at Auction
of Alabama, containing forty acres more or less, bounded by an acre
according to the official plan of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said William Moore.

NOVEMBER 18, 1820, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, has given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William Moore
and to his heirs the said tract above described.
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature, heretofore belonging unto the said
William Moore.

In testimony whereof, I, Martin Van Buren,
President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be affixed.

Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine and of the Independence of the United States
