~~Whereas~~ William Moore, of Shelby County, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Moore, according to the provisions of the Act of April 1839, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter of the West East quarter of Section thirty six in Township Twicken, of Range Two, East in the District of lands subject to sale at Shalabrook, Alabama, containing forty acre more or less, the necessity of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said William Moore.

~~Now know ye~~, that the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William Moore, and to his heirs the said tract above described, and to his heirs the said tract above described.

We have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature, demands belonging unto the said William Moore.
