Lee &amp; wife, Betty Jo Lee, as joint tenants with right of survivorship all our

right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, to wit:

The  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ , the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of the  $NW\frac{1}{4}$ , the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of the  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ , and the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of the  $SW\frac{1}{2}$ , less 7 acres west of Spring Creek, formerly known as the John Black House Place, and now belonging to A. E. Hamm, as described in DeedBook 163 page 454 in the office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama, all in Section 14, Township 22, Range 3 West; and the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of the  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23, Township 22, Range 3 West.
