Third. I will and bequeath to Robert Heffernan Woy the sum of One Thousand Dollars.

Fourth . I will and bequeath to ^{my} Son-in-law, Ernest Raiford Ellis, the sum of One Thousand Dollars.

Fifth. I will and bequeath to my beloved Grandson , James Raiford Ellis, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars of my Life Insurance to be set aside and invested , preferably with the Life Insurance Company until he reaches the age of ~~Sixteen~~ Sixteen years. To be used for his College education.

Sixth. I will and bequeath to my beloved Grandson , Robert Goodloe Ellis, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars of my Life Insurance to be set aside and invested , preferably with the Life Insurance Company. until he reaches the age of Sixteen years. to be used for his College education.

Seventh. I will and bequeath to my beloved Grandson, Leon Charles Ellis, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars of my Life Insurance to be set aside and invested , preferably with the Life Insurance Company until he reaches the age of Sixteen Years, to be used for his College education .

Eighth. I will and bequeath to my beloved Daughter, Leone Heffernan Ellis, all my personal property consisting of money , notes, mortgages, bonds, furniture, automobile and any and all other chattels and all my real estate that I may be possessed of at my death , after all other bequests as outlined above have been paid. I also will and bequeath to said Daughter , all my Life Insurance except the amounts to be paid to the Three Grandsons as before stated.

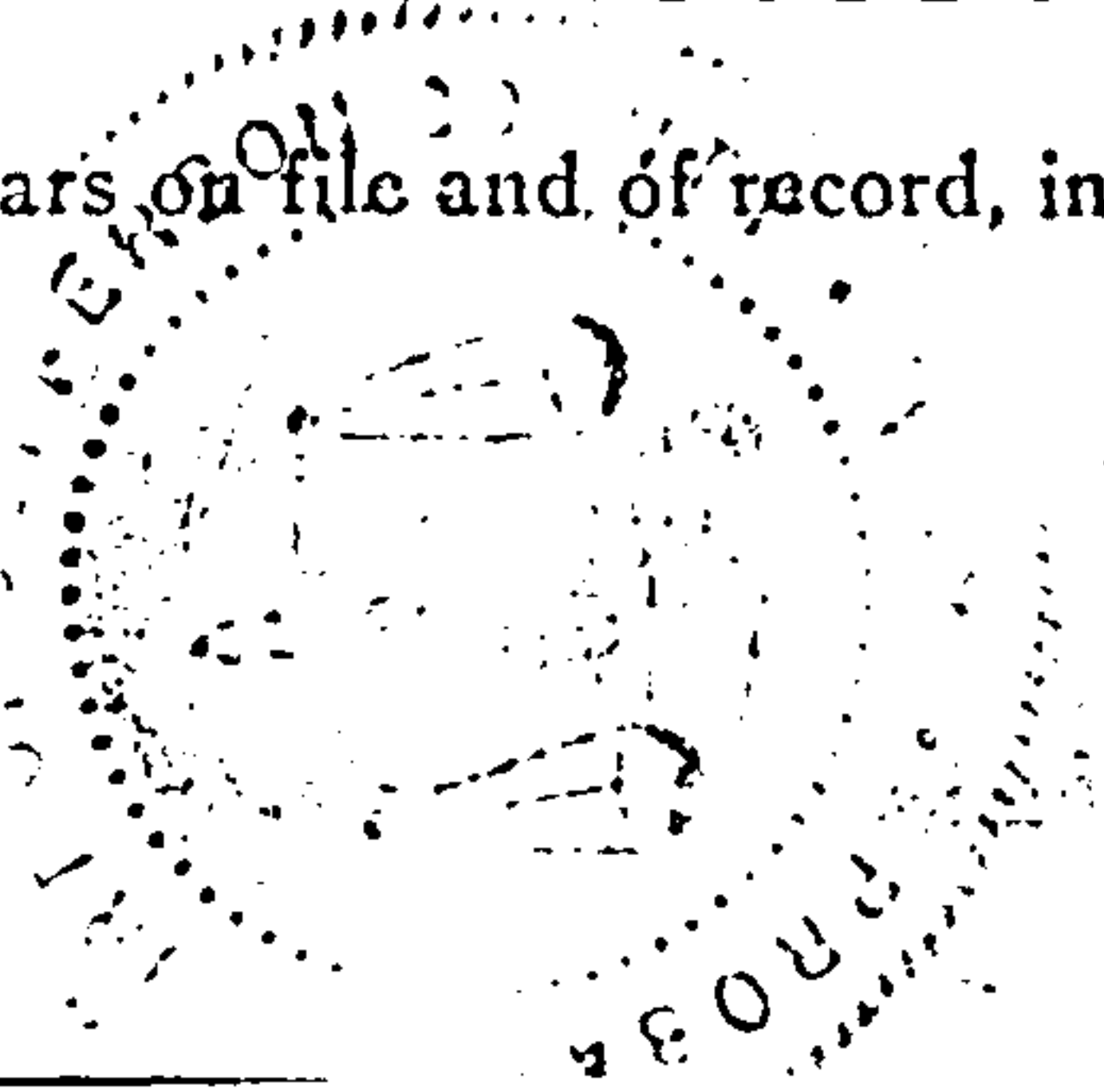
