

PETITION AND WRITTEN DECLARATION OF VACATION OF A  
PORTION OF AN ABANDONED ROAD

STATE OF ALABAMA

FILED 9 MARCH 1959

SHELBY COUNTY

WHEREAS, we, the undersigned persons being the owners of the land abutting that portion of the road, street or alley hereinafter described, do hereby certify that the same has not been used for more than 20 years as a public road and for the purpose of letting the record show the same is abandoned and vacated, we, John H. Farr and wife, Mary Farr, and Ted Riley and wife, Edith Riley, do desire to and now, therefore, do hereby declare said roadway is vacated. Said road being vacated being described as follows:

That certain abandoned and unused roadway which formerly was a part of the Columbiana-Wilsonville public road and which enters the hereinafter described land in the south-westerly corner thereof and runs in a northeasterly direction and leaves said land in the northeasterly corner thereof. Said land across which said roadway heretofore ran being described as follows:

A part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 24, Township 21 South, Range 1 West, more particularly described as follows:  
Commence at the SW corner of said forty and run north 2 deg. 35 min. west along said forty line 420 feet; run thence north 84 deg. 53 min. East 207.8 feet; thence 114 deg. 46 min. to the left 27.2 feet for the point of beginning, and from said point of beginning run thence 114 deg. 46 min. to the right (along the north line of easement for road sold to Frank C. and Christine Ellis) 287.5 feet to the west right of way line of Highway No. 25; thence 70 deg. 54 min. to the left 226.1 feet (being along the west right of way line of Ala. Highway 25); thence 109 deg. 06 min. to the left 459.6 feet, more or less, to the Frank C. and Christine Ellis property; thence 114 deg. 46 min. to the left (along the Frank C. and Christine Ellis land line) 234.4 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.81 acres, more or less; situated in Shelby County, Ala.

Petitioners further certify that such vacation will not deprive other property owners of such right as they may have to convenient means of ingress and egress to and from their property.

Petitioners further show that said property is within the corporate limits of the town of Columbiana, Alabama; wherefore, petitioners do pray that the Mayor and Town Council of said town do give their consent for said above described abandoned roadway to be vacated, the said assent to be evidenced by a resolution passed by said Mayor and Town Council.
