NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, that the Mayor and Town Council give their assent, and do hereby give their consent for the vacation of that certain portion of an abandoned road more fully described in the attached petition.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution, certified by the Clerk, be filed and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, with the written petition and declaration of vacation of a portion of an abandoned road.

WHEREAS, we, the undersigned persons being the owners of the land abutting that portion of the road, street or alley hereinafter described, do hereby certify that the same has not been used for more than 20 years as a public road and for the purpose of letting the record show the same is abandoned and vacated, we, Dewey F. Bolton and wife, Sadie Bolton, do desire to and now, therefore, do hereby declare said roadway vacated. Said road being vacated being described as follows:

That certain abandoned and unused roadway which formerly was a part of the Columbiana-Harpersville public road and which enters the hereinafter described land in the southwesterly corner thereof and runs in a northeasterly direction and leaves said land in the northeasterly corner thereof. Said land across which said roadway heretofore ran being described as follows: Commence at the southwest corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 2 East, as established by J. L. Ray, Alabama Registered Civil Engineer and Licensed Surveyor, No. 1570, and from said point run north, 21 degrees 34 minutes west, 51.20 feet to a concrete post on the south right of way line of Southern Railway; thence north 30 degrees west, 50 feet to the center line of said Railway; thence continue in the same direction 86 feet to the northwest corner of Wilsonville depot lot; being the point of beginning; thence north 18 degrees 45 minutes west along the east line of that certain street crossing said railroad and running in a northerly direction through the business section of said Town of Wilsonville, Alabama, a distance of 125.5 feet to the south line of Alabama Highway 25; thence north 57 degrees 50 minutes east along the chord of an arc 93.69 feet to a point; thence north, 46 degrees 43 minutes east along the chord of an arc 104.35 feet to the northwest corner of Flournoy lot; thence along said Flournoy lot run south, 62 degrees 52 minutes east, 23.72 feet; thence south 26 degrees 36 minutes east, 166.60 feet to the Southern Railway Company right of way; thence along same run south, 60 degrees west, 39.41 feet; thence north, 30 degrees west, 36 feet; thence south, 60 degrees west, and along the Wilsonville Depot lot run 72.50 feet; thence continue south, 60 degrees west along said depot lot 110.50 feet to the point of beginning. Said lot being situated in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 21 South, Range 1 East and in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

Petitioners further certify that such vacation will not deprive other property owners of such right as they may have to convenient means of ingress and egress to and from their property.

Petitioners further show that said property is within the corporate limits of the Town of Wilsonville, Alabama; wherefore, petitioners do pray that the Mayor and Town Council of said Town do give their consent for said above described abandoned roadway to be vacated, the said assent to be evidenced by a resolution passed by said Mayor and Town Council.
