My name is Gertrude Shields. I am the wife of L. P. Shields and am one and the same person who joined with said L. P. Shields in the execution of a mortgage to J. M. Springer for \$500.00 on July 25, 1939, as shown by mortgage recorded in Mortgage Book 181 page 78 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Affiant further says she recalls the transaction which gave rise to the execution of said mortgage and that her husband had purchased the timber described in said mortgage from J. M. Springer and had paid him \$850.00 down on the purchase price and then had agreed to pay him \$500.00 which was evidenced by said mortgage. Affiant further says she knows that said mortgage was paid in full and that there is no balance due on the same. Affiant further says her husband only had 3 years in which to cut the timber described in said mortgage and he cut the same within said 3 years and paid said mortgage during the time he was cutting said timber. Affiant further says that L. P. Shields died on December 14, 1940, and that neither she nor the Estate make any further claim to said timber or the land on which the same was situated.

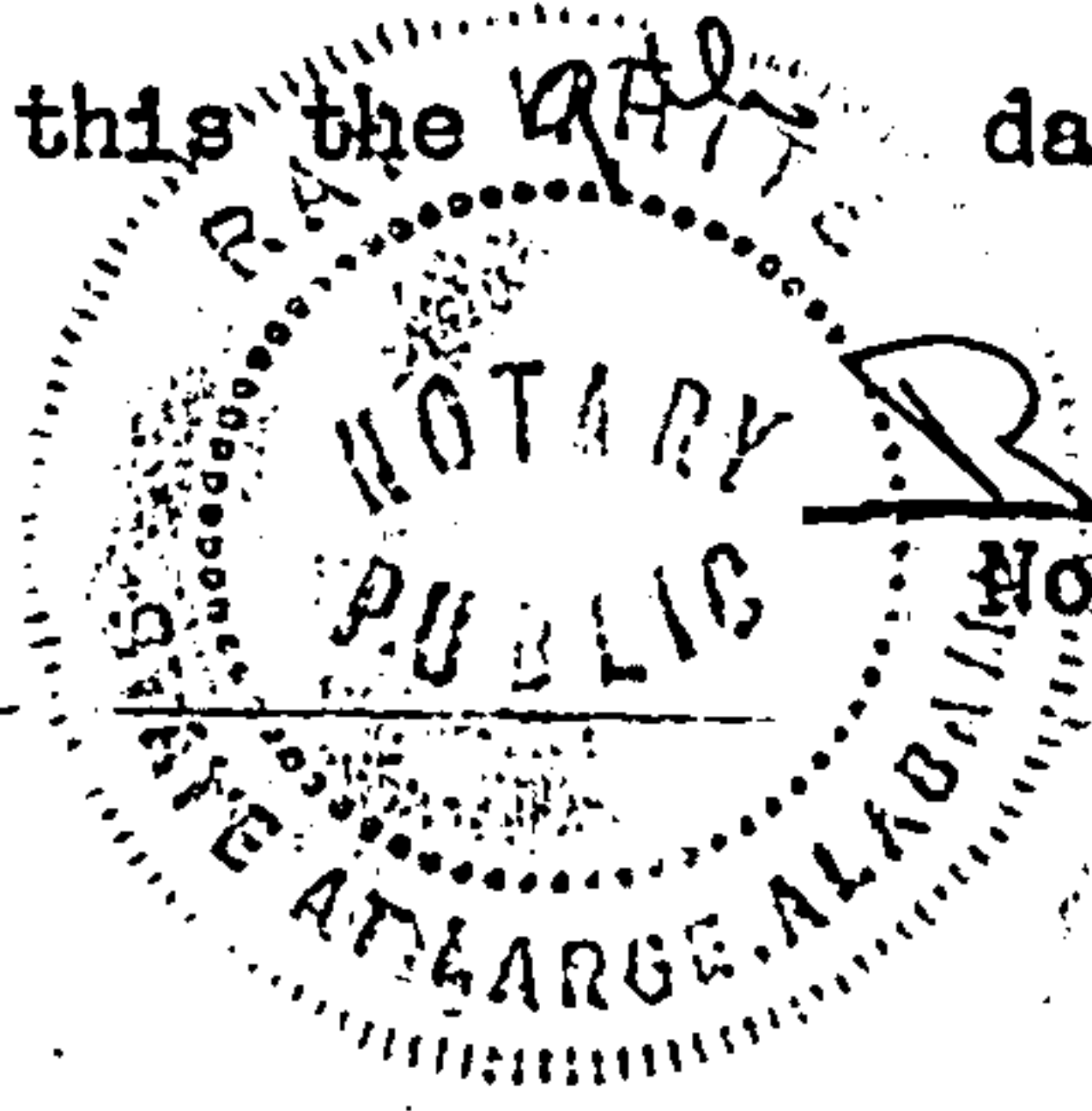
