

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that, in consideration of the conveyance simultaneously herewith by M. C. Crow and wife, Helen J. Crow, to United States Steel Corporation, a New Jersey corporation, of the minerals and mining rights in certain land located in Section 2, Township 19 South, Range 3 West, Jefferson County, Alabama, receipt whereof is acknowledged, said UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION, hereinafter referred to as "Grantor," does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto said M. And the Grantor does for itself and for its successors and assigns, covenant with the Grantee, Grantee's heirs and assigns, that it is lawfully seized in fee simple of said minerals conveyed hereby; that they are free from all encumbrances, except as herein mentioned; that it has a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and it will and its successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same to the Grantee, Grantee's heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

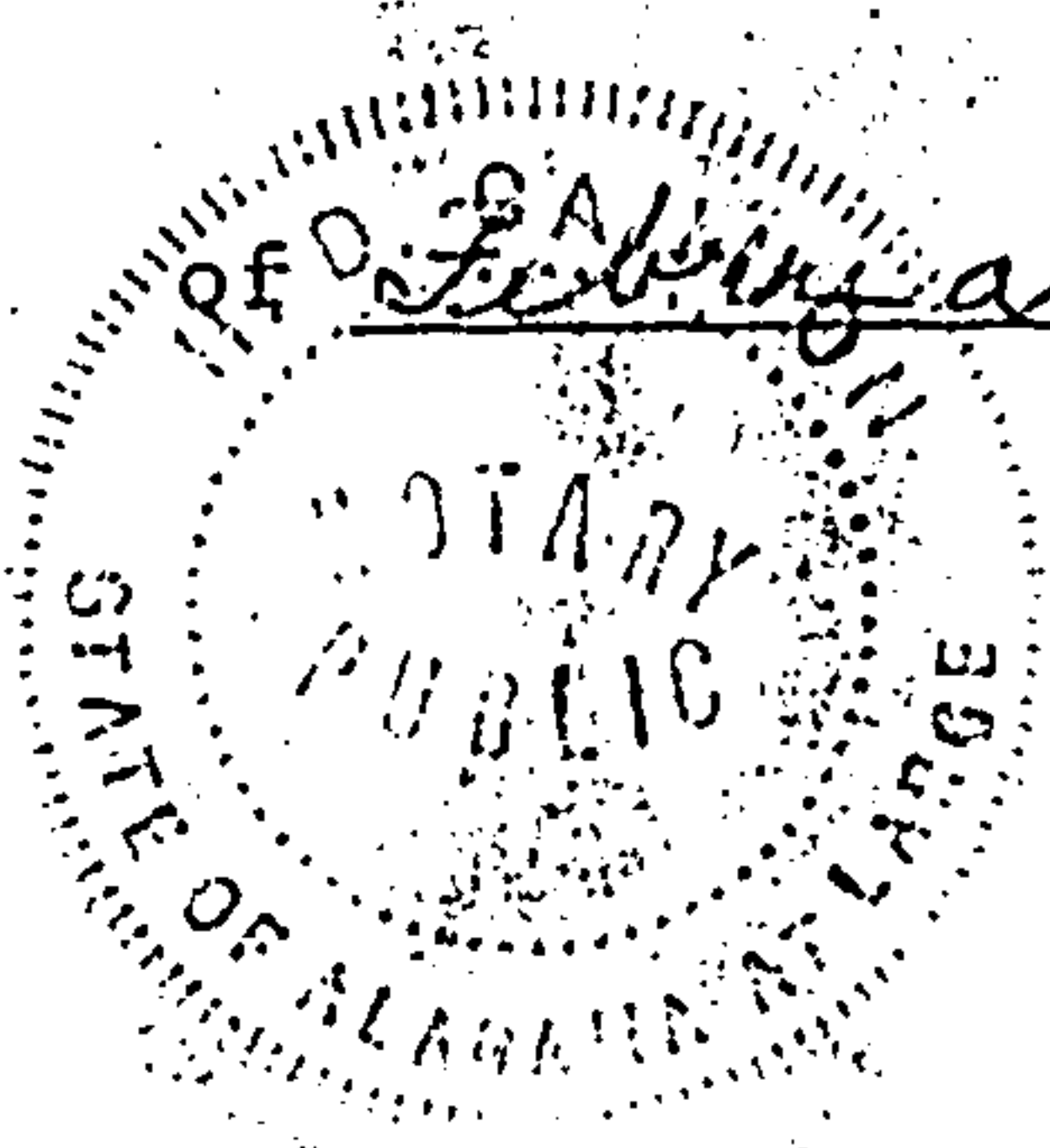
