I remember the day of the death of the said C. E. Goodwin for the reason that he died on my front porch. I had known the said C. E. Goodwin since about the year 1920. I remember that it was during the year 1938 that C. E. Goodwin died, and that M. B. Goodwin is the surviving wife and unmarried on July 15, 1944.
