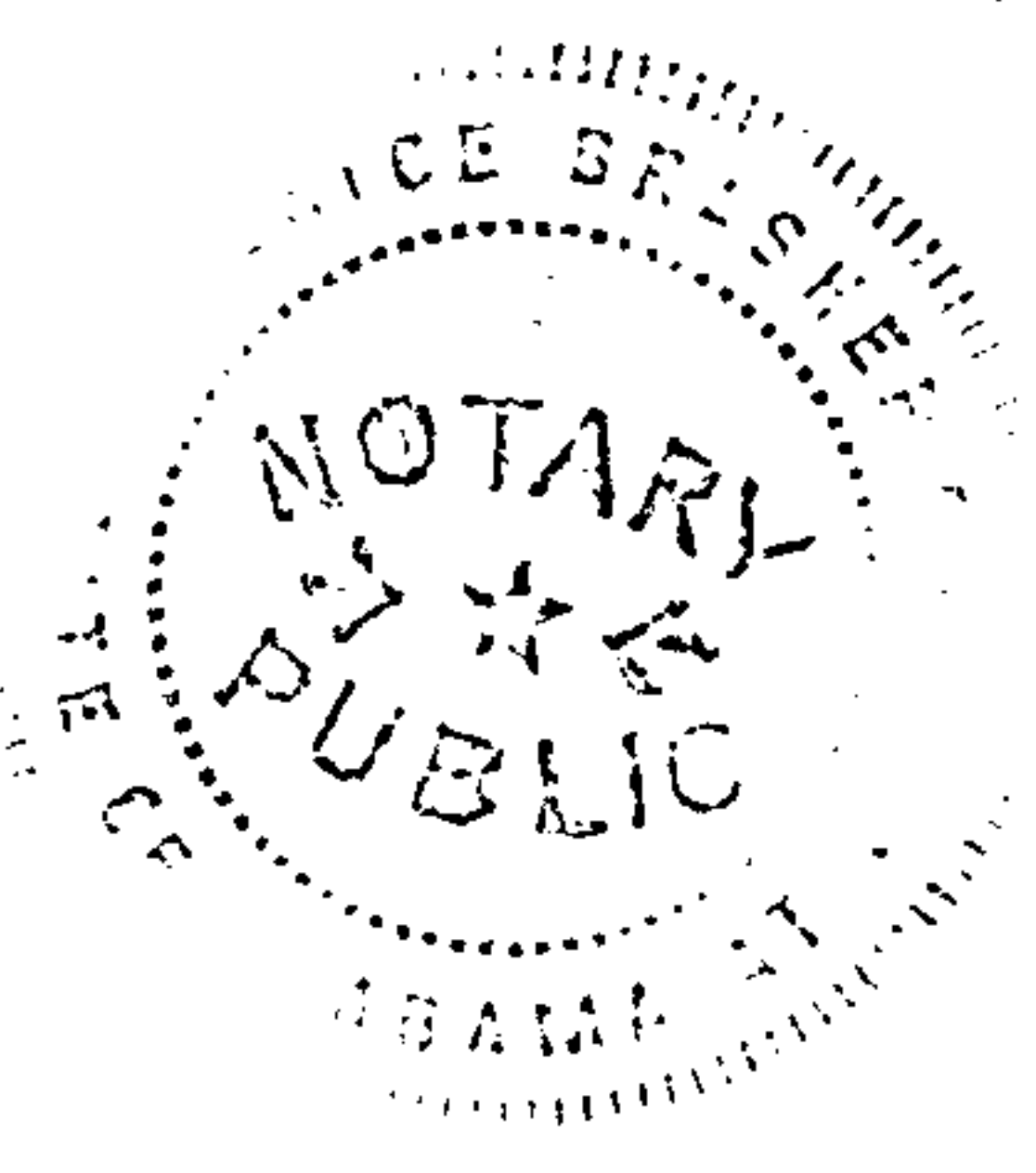
2 3/4 acres in the NW corner of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4, Section 17 Township 22, Range 1 East.
