Commence at the Northwest corner of Section 33, Township 21, South, Range 2 West, and run South 60 degrees 17 minutes East a distance of 1759.60 feet to a point onthe West right of way line of Highway #31; and point of beginning; thence run South 70 degrees 45 min. West a distance of 1074.98 feet; thence South 13 deg. 53 min. East a distance of 197.82 feet; thence South 77 deg. 57 min. West a distance of 110.69 feet; thence South 9 deg. 22 min. East a distance of 478.10 feet; thence South 51 deg. 55 min. East a distance of 105.68 feet; thence South 75 deg. 24 min. East a distance of 209-54 feet; thence South 15 deg. 53 min. East a distance of 740.04 feet; thence North 80 deg. 21 min. East a distance of 481.68 feet; thence North 78 deg. 48 min. East a distance of 514.85 feet to a point on the West right of way line of Highway 31; thence North 14 deg. 14 min. West along the right of way line of said highway a distance of 940.69 feet; thence North 17 deg. 05 min. West along said right of way line a distance of 814.46 feet to point of beginning. Situated in Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama.

Our attention is called to the fact that Longview Lime Corporation executed a quit claim deed to us, dated March 19, 1956, which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 179, page 30, but the only land we claim in the SW of NW of Section 33, Township 21, Range 2 West (which was conveyed, among other property, in daid deed) is West of what is now known as the S. J. Jackson Place, formerly known as the Mabry Place and prior to that the Johnson Place. In other words, the only land we claim in that forty is that portion of the forty West of Jackson Place as hereinabove described, andwe have never been in possession nor have we claimed any portions of captioned property now owned by S. J. Jackson.
