KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned owners, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), in hand paid by B. George, and other good and valuable considerations, do hereby assign, sell and transfer and set over unto B. George, his heirs or assigns, all of our right, title and interest in and to any monies or sum of monies which we shall realize from the sale of Clay Gravel from pit or pits located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, in Township 20 South, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama, lying on the Shelby County side of the Coosa River.

As further consideration for the execution of this Assignment, B. George agrees to release from the terms and conditions of that certain mortgage, the clay gravel pit or pits as described above. The mortgage referred to is recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, in Mortgage Record Book 245, page 353, being recorded on September 9, 1956. This assignment shall not in anywise affect the validity of the mortgage above mentioned, which shall remain in full force and effect, insofar as the other property therein described is concerned.

It is further agreed by B. George, that all monies or sum of monies realized from the sale of the clay gravel will be applied by B. George in reduction of the principal and interest due on the mortgage referred to above. Any amounts received shall be first applied toward the accrued interest on the principal amount, balance to the principal amount of the mortgage.

It is further agreed by all parties hereto that the amount realized from the sale of said clay gravel shall be applied on last numbered note or notes covered by said above mentioned mortgage, working in reverse order, and shall not disturb or change the regular annual note coming due in consecutive order on the 30th day of December of each year.

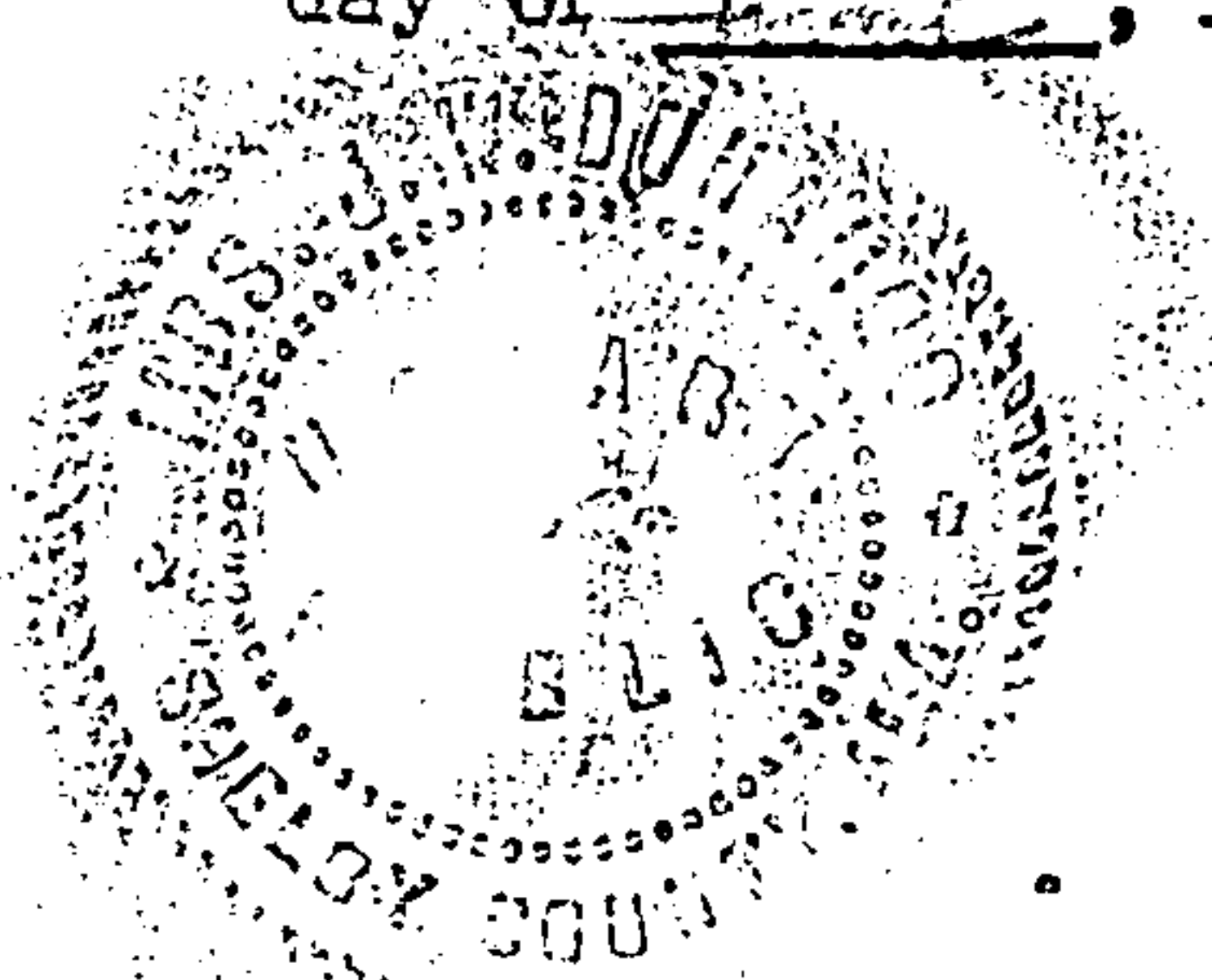
