Murrah was the father of your affiant and was the mortgagor in that certain mortgage given to Joseph Carroll, dated January 7, 1914, and filed May 25, 1914, securing \$1296.00 and recorded in Mortgage Book 103, on page 218, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and conveying, among other lands, the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 2, Township 21, Range 3 West, except that portion North of the John Allen Branch, in Shelby County, Alabama; affiant further says that his best recollection is that said indebtedness was due in two or three years after the date of said mortgage, and that he knows of his own personal knowledge that his father, C.C. Murrah, paid the indebtedness secured by said mortgage in full, to the mortgagee therein named.

Affiant further says that the indebtedness due S.W. Pardue by note and mortgage by E.L. Fulton and K.E. Fulton, dated June 1, 1934, securing \$325.00, which was filed as a claim against the estate of Elijah L. Fulton, was paid in full by Azora Fulton as Executrix of the estate of E.L. Fulton, being the same person as Elijah L. Fulton, together with interest in the total amount of \$372.75, on November 30th., 1937, by check payable to the said S.W. Pardue.

Affiant further says that Mrs. Azora Fulton was the mother-in-law of your affiant, and that the said Mrs. Azora Fulton departed this life in Shelby County, Alabama, on the 3rd day of November, 1942.
