That the above named parties are all of the next of kin of the said Dr. J. Weldon Moon, deceased, and that all of the above named parties are over the age of 21 years.

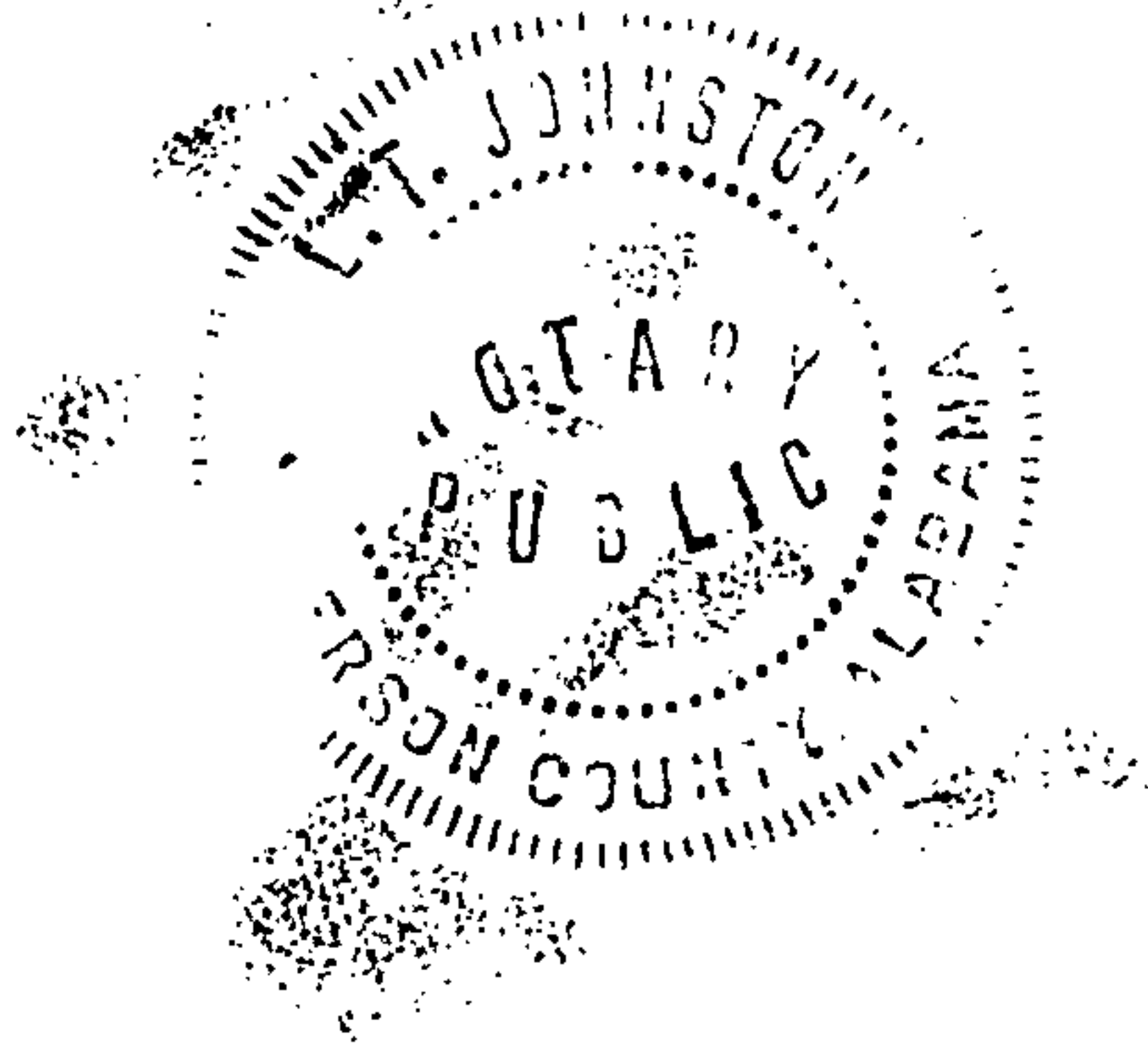
That there has been no administration on the estate of the said Dr. J. Weldon Moon, deceased, that he owed no debts at the time of his death necessitating an administration on his said estate.
