I know of my own personal knowledge that said Martha Jane Ozley and her heirs, as listed above, have been in open, peaceable, continuous, undisurbed, exclusive adverse possession of all of the above described property since prior to 1909 and until the present date, claiming/own the same against the claims of all persons whatsoever. I have never heard anyone question the title or ownership of said Martha Jane Ozley and her heirs, as listed above. I know of my own personal knowledge that Forrest R. Crim has/never occupied, owned and possessed any part of the above described property.
