Butler which adjoins a portion of the property acquired by me as stated on the South (at a point where my property is fenced) and lies East of the old Oxmoor Road and West of the East section line.

During the period of time I have been familiar with this property I have never known anyone but Butler to claim any interest in the same; except that for several years since around 1950 this property was subject to a lease sale contract in favor of Steven E. Dill who had possession, so I understand, under the lease sale contract. Later the property was reacquired by the Butlers. I am not familiar with Butler's title but do know that he has maintained a cabin located on the said property and has been in possession of the same openly and obviously except the time that Dill was in possession. I have never heard of anyone claiming against Butler and the
