A part of the  $W_2^1$  of  $NW_4^1$  of Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 1 West, more particularly described as follows: Commence at the northwest corner of the  $NE_4^1$  of  $NW_4^1$  of Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 1 West and run south, 1 deg. 51 min. east along west line, a distance of 1238.17 feet to the south right of way line of County Highway #32; thence run south 78 deg. 57 min. west along the south right of way line of said road, a distance of 104.71 feet to point of beginning of lot herein described and conveyed; thence continue south, 78 deg. 57 min. west a distance of 210 feet; thence run north, 78 deg. 57 min. east a distance of 210 feet; thence run north, 78 deg. 57 min. east a distance of 210 feet; thence run north, 11 deg. 03 min. west a distance of 210 feet to point of beginning.

Excepting 2/3 interest in oil located under above lands.
