Whereas certain lands of the County of Shelby, North Carolina, have been divided in the General Land Office of the United States, according to the Register of the Land Office at Charlotte, North Carolina, and it appears that full payment has been made by the said Robert Davis

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the best half of the certain tract of land of section of section thirty four in Township thirteen of Range five East and in the District of South Carolina and State of North Carolina containing Eighty acres

According to the office of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Robert Davis

NOT KNOWING YET, THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Robert Davis and his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract above described. To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Robert Davis and his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, J. James Thomas, President of the United States of America, has caused these letters to be made Public, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the thirty-first day of August, 1861, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, and of the Independence of the United States the forty-eighth.
