Whereas Martin Price, of Shady Brook, Georgia, a citizen of the United States, a copyist of the Land Office at Decatur, Georgia, & appears that full payment has been made by the said Martin Price, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 2d of May, 1882, enacted in making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands for the State of Georgia, to the Collector of the Public Land Office at Decatur, Georgia, in the sum of \$100,000,000, to be used for the payment of debts, taxes, and interest, including interest, amounting to the official value of the sum of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said sum has been paid out by the said Martin Price;

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Martin Price, and to his heirs the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature, heretofore belonging unto the said tract of land, in fee simple, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
