Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said State and County personally appeared R. D. Crim, Jr., who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says: in Judgment Record G at page 37 is shown a judgment in favor of L. G. Fulton, Register of Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, against R. D. Crim, dated October 14, 1957, for the sum of \$130.47. The judgment debtor, R. D. Crim, was ~~the~~ father to affiant and said R. D. Crim had no interest in or title to the following land, namely:

A part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, described as follows: Beginning at the SW corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20 and run East along South line, 140 yards; thence North 175 yards; thence West 140 yards to West line of said forty acres; thence South along West line of said forty acres 175 yards to point of beginning, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Said land above described was not involved in the litigation made the basis of the aforementioned judgment but other lands were involved and consequently the judgment is not a lien on the above described property which is now owned by affiant.

Affiant further states that the judgment shown in Judgment Record G, page 189 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, dated June 29, 1959, for \$230.95 was rendered against Mrs. R. D. Crim who had no interest whatsoever in the land described hereinabove in this affidavit and did not constitute a lien on captioned property. This said judgment however has been satisfied and paid out of the proceeds of condemnation suit ~~and paid to~~ <sup>by the</sup> State of Alabama in which an award was made in favor of Mrs. R. D. Crim and on the distribution of said award by decree of The Honorable Conrad M. Fowler, Judge of Probate for Shelby County, Alabama.

The said sum of \$230.95 was decreed to be paid out of said award to L. G. Fulton, Clerk of Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, and was paid to him out of the fiduciary funds in the hands of said judge of probate and has been satisfied of record.
