McHenry according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 27th of April, 1839 entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the West half of the South East quarter section twenty one, of Range Two West, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing seventy three acres, and ninety two hundred and one and one-half acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Survey General, which said tract has been purchased by the said John N. McHenry
