the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

A tract of land in Shelby County, Alabama, particularly described as follows: Begin at the SW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 18, Range 1 West, from said corner go North 86 degrees 30' East along the South line of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 198 feet, thence North 2 degrees 30' West, 1320 feet; thence South 86 degrees 30' West 198 feet; thence South 2 degrees 30' East 509 feet; thence North 65 degrees 30' West 1522 feet to West line of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South 2 degrees 30' East 200 feet to SE corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South 42 degrees 30' West 700 feet; thence South 70 degrees 40' East 495 feet to West line of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South 62 degrees 30' East 1250 feet; thence South 32 degrees 40' West 623 feet; thence South 57 degrees 20' East 750 feet; thence North 2 degrees 30' West 940 feet to point of beginning, excepting minerals and mining rights to all of the above described property.

heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances;

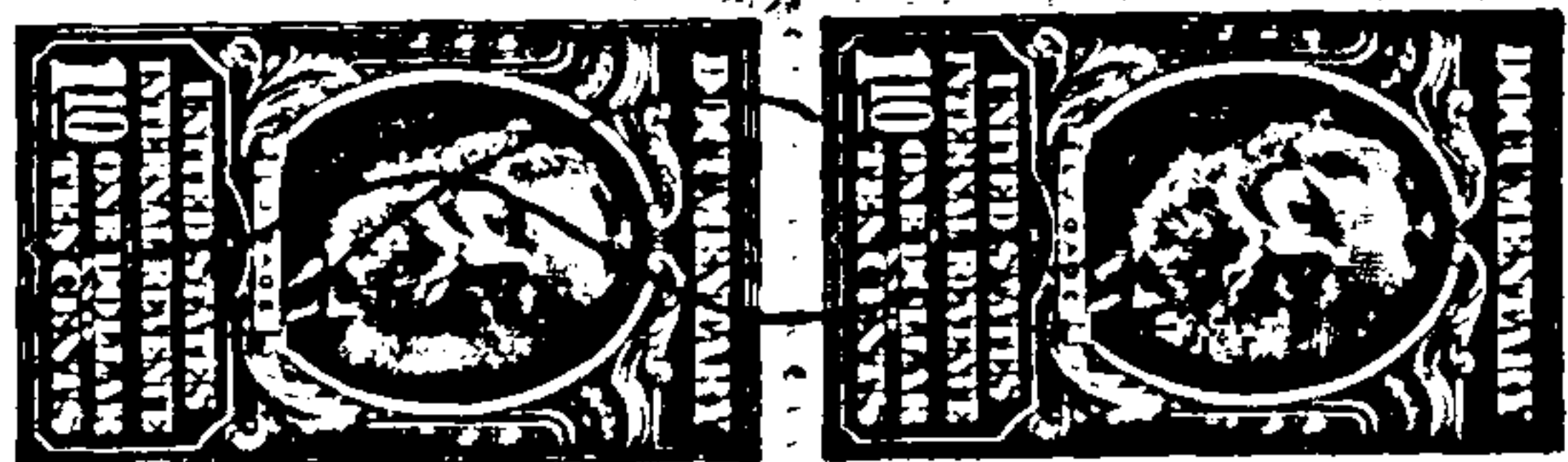
that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will, and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said
