for and on account of Cruelty.

It appearing to the Court that the agreement heretofore entered into by and between parties in this cause is just and proper, it is therefore, further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the agreement be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed, and that the parties are hereby ordered to keep and abide by the terms of said agreement, and said agreement is hereby included in and made a part of this decree as if fully set out herein.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that L. H. Bentley PAY THE COST herein taxed, for which execution may issue. be, and— hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that L. H. Bentley and Almeda Bentley, each, be permitted to again contract marriage after sixty days from rendition of this decree, if there be no appeal the— pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue. from same, upon payment of the costs of this suit.
