1. We are 75 years and 78 years of age respectively, and have resided in Helena, Shelby County, Alabama, all of our lives.

2. We have known Perl Gill, the widow of Sam Gill for sixteen years, which is as long as she has lived in Helena, Alabama. We also knew Sam Gill, who died in January of 1958 and who was the husband of the said Perl Gill. Sam Gill died intestate in Shelby County, and left surviving him as his only heirs at law, the said Perl Gill and one daughter, Annie Gill. And that he owed no debt at the time of his death.

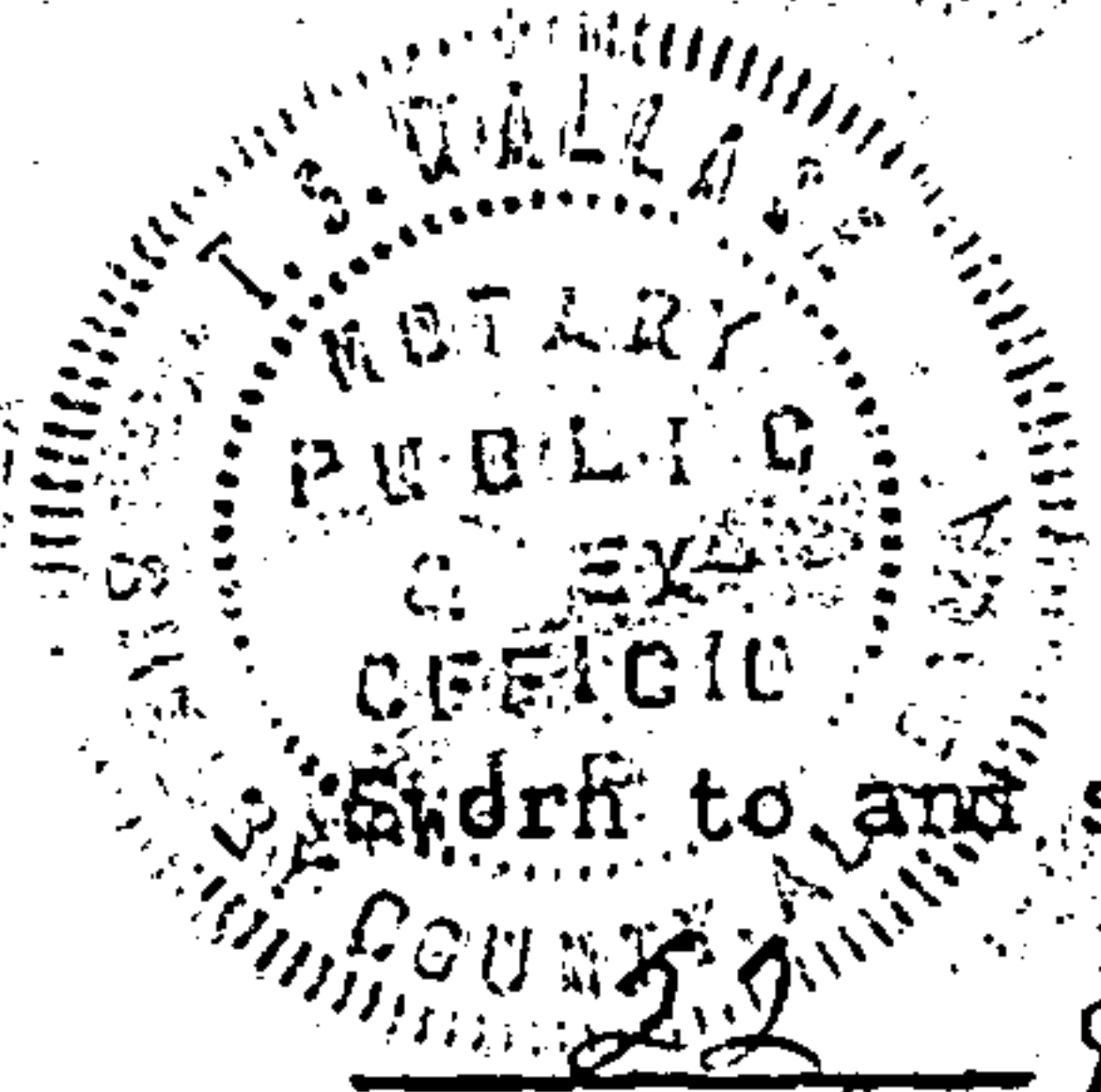
3. There were no other children born to the marriage of the said Perl and Sam Gill.

4. That the said Sam Gill and wife, Perl Gill, purchased some lots in Helena, Shelby County, Alabama in 1943, said lots being known as Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Block C of Liberty Heights, Helena, Shelby County, Alabama, from G. B. Pickett and wife, Marie D. Pickett.

That said Sam Gill and wife, Perl Gill, went into immediate possession of the said lots and that they continued in the possession of the same until the death of Sam Gill and thereafter the said Perl Gill has continued in the possession of the same. That said possession was open, notorious, hostile, peaceable and adverse to all the world under color of title.

6. We have never heard the title to the said lots of the said Sam Gill and wife, Perl Gill, questioned or contested in any way.
