Whereas

Benjamin Huggins has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Montgomery, Alabama*

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Benjamin Huggins*

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the cost of the said *Benjamin Huggins* in the District of *Alabama* and State of *Alabama* containing *forty* acres

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Benjamin Huggins*

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Benjamin Huggins* and to his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Benjamin Huggins*
