Kidd according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North East quarter of Section twenty eight, in Township nineteen, of Range two East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing eighty acres and twenty five hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **COMMISSIONER GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *John M. Kidd*

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *John M. Kidd*

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *John M. Kidd*

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
